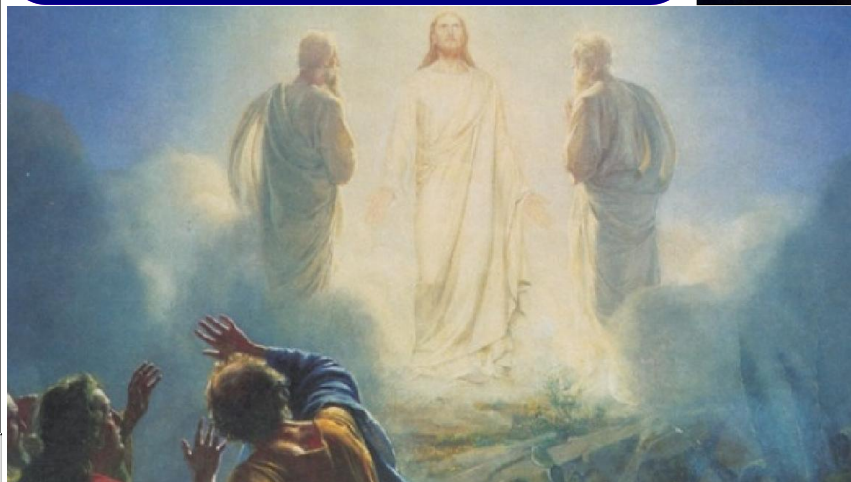

LENTEN REMINDERS



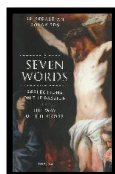

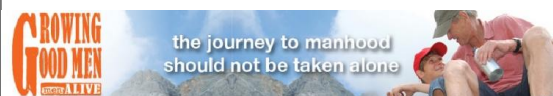
