

AND FROM THE BIBLE SOCIETY ... Will you provide Bibles to Iraqi refugees?

Iraqi Christians have faced persecution. They've been threatened. They've fled their homes. But it's reawakened their faith – and now, many are asking for Bibles. It's hard for us to imagine what it means to receive a Bible when you've lost everything, but let me tell you what one refugee said. Ghassan fled Iraq with his wife and two girls when ISIS came to their house and threatened to kill the family unless they left or converted to Islam. "Our faith is deep within us so we were not ready to give that up," said Ghassan. "We were in desperate need of financial help... but we were more in need of spiritual help." The Society's team in the region helped the family in practical ways and provided them with the Bible they longed for. God's word gave them hope and comfort in their darkest hours. "I may have lost all my property and my money, but I have gained Jesus Christ – and this was real gain," said Ghassan.


