WE HAVE FABULOUS NEWS!

COMMUNITIES GRANT

We won a Communities Grant from the NSW government of \$31,250 to be used specifically to replace the flooring in the church body!

As some of you already know we have been working hard over the last couple of weeks to have the very old and very marked carpet on the platform leading to the sanctuary tiled, and the result is truly beautiful. We have used marble tiles and not only do they enhance the area, they meld all materials currently used at the sanctuary area beautifully producing a cohesive sanctuary space.

As you are aware the carpet in the church is 20+ years old and has faded so badly that it permanently looks dirty and winning this grant has allowed a dream come true as we wondered how we would ever afford to be able to replace it. We were lucky enough to have the new carpet laid just in time for the church to be opened according to the government's COVID-19 advice and we hope you agree that it works beautifully!

We now have renewed floor surfaces in the body of the church and the choir loft [which will be replaced this Tuesday] at no cost to the parish as all work has been covered by the limit of the grant and thankfully that 3. PLEASE BE ON TIME AS THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED means we don't have to factor in that cost for many more vears to come!

REGARDING MASSES: NO MORE THAN 10 [11 INCLUDING THE PRIEST] ARE ALLOWED IN THE CHURCH TO ATTEND **MASS**

Regulating this, as you could well understand, is extremely problematical and we ask for your patience, and consideration of others. The only way we can do this which would be fair is to ask you to:

- CONTACT THE PARISH OFFICE BY PHONE OR EMAIL TO BOOK YOUR ATTENDANCE AT ONE OF THE MANY MASSES PROVIDED EACH WEEKEND OR WEEKDAY
- PLEASE NOTE TO MAXIMISE THE NUMBERS AT MASS YOU MAY BE ASKED TO READ SO PLEASE NOMINATE WHEN BOOKING.
- AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF MASS
- When you have booked your attendance, giving your name and those who will be attending with you, your place will be held and when you arrive for Mass - entry only via the York Street western door - you will need to sign the register available at the foyer.
- We invite you to contact anyone you know who isn't on the internet and therefore not receiving this information to ask them to contact the office to make a booking.
- REMEMBER WE HAVE MORE MASSES NOW SO DON'T FORGET TO DROP IN / HAND TO THE PRIEST / EMAIL YOUR MASS INTENTION REMEMBERING YOUR LOVED ONES.
- WEEKDAY MASSES [MONDAY TO FRIDAY ONLY -SATURDAY MORNINGS INCLUDED ABOVE]
- PLEASE CONTACT THE OFFICE TO BOOK YOUR ATTENDANCE ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING **SCHEDULE**
- 9AM DAILY [ADORATION FROM 8.30AM]
- 10.30AM DAILY INCLUDING LIVE **STREAMING** [ADORATION FROM 10AM]
- REGARDING PRIVATE PRAYER:
- THE FOYER OF THE CHURCH ONLY WILL BE OPEN EACH DAY DURING OFFICE HOURS, BUT EXCLUDING MASS TIMES, FOR PRIVATE DEVOTION.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT NO MORE THAN FOUR ARE TO BE IN THE FOYER, SPACED AT 1.5M APART, AT ANY ONE TIME.
- THE CHAPEL AT THE ADMIN CENTRE WILL ALSO BE OPEN FOR NO MORE THAN 2 PERSONS AS A TIME.

HEARING AID LOOP IN THE CHURCH.



There is a Hearing Aid induction loop installed in St Patricks which covers all Pews on the left side of the church.

This hearing aid loop device allows hearing aid users to hear anyone using a microphone.

To access the loop switch your hearing aid to the position you use to listen on the telephone.

Most hearing aids have at least three switch positions and usually, the second or third position is for on the phone or an installed loop system, like the one installed inside St Pats.

If your hearing Aid seems to be unable to avail of this facility, or you are unsure how to use it, advice on its use is available. Please advise the office if you wish to have help or advice. A group discussion and demonstration can be arranged.

COMMENTARY **BY MARY COLOE PBVM**

'The Father will give you another Paraclete.'

This Gospel continues from last Sunday as Jesus offers consolation to his disciples on the eve of his departure. Today we hear of the Spirit who will come to the disciples when Jesus returns to his Father. Because the Spirit will come and dwell with them, the disciples will not be left orphaned; they will not be left alone and desolate. The Spirit dwelling in the community will continue to mediate the presence of God

In the OT there was no distinction between the loss of both parents and the loss of a father. To be an orphan was to be 'fatherless,' without a protector. During the Exile Israel cried out, 'We have become orphans, fatherless' (Lam 5:3). The image of the orphan hearkens back to the opening verses of John 14, which were discussed in last week's commentary: 'In my Father's household are many dwellings.' Even though the physical Jesus of Nazareth is no longer with the disciples, they are promised that the Father, Jesus and Spirit will dwell in them. They will still dwell within the Father's house/hold and so will not be left 'fatherless'.

When Jesus says, 'I live' the evangelist uses a form of the verb zoē. In John's Gospel this term is used to describe not just ordinary life (bios) but the intimate life of God which Jesus participates in and following his death, when disciples are drawn into his relationship with God, they too will have, they too 'will live'. Right now, disciples have ordinary mortal life (bios), but in and through Jesus they will become part of the household of God and will have eternity life (zoē). As this Gospel says, 'I am in my Father and you in me and I in you.' Here, before the events of the crucifixion, Jesus interprets the meaning of his death for his disciples. His death in John is called his return to the Father. Death is the means of his returning to the original glory of his being with God. But in his death, disciples become brothers and sisters and children of God.

The word 'Paraclete/Advocate' comes from the world of legal dealings. It can seem a strange word but it is the image Jesus offers to emphasise we have God on our side. The Greek word is based on the word 'to call' and so it means 'one who answers the call' or one who is called on for support - thus ad-vocate. John's community was engaged in a struggle with both the Roman world and the Jewish world where Christianity had its origins. This is the context in which Jesus speaks of the Spirit as the Advocate in these struggles. The one who will answer their call, who will help and offer support.

Today, our context is different but we still have much to struggle with in a society that no longer lives out and publicly espouses Gospel values. We still need the Spirit to


