RECOGNITION OF THE MIRACLE

ATTRIBUTED TO FR. FRANCIS JORDAN

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has authorised the promulgation of the decree regarding the miracle attributed to the intercession of Father Francis Mary of the Cross (in secular life John Baptist) JORDAN, Founder of the Salvatorians.

BIOGRAPHICAL DATA

Father Francis Jordan was born on 16 June 1848 in Gurtweil, a small town in the

archdiocese of Freiburg (Germany). After ordination to the priesthood on 21 July 1878, he was sent to Rome, where he spent most part of his life. Motivated by the apostolic zeal and desire to make Jesus Christ, Saviour of the world, known and loved by all people, everywhere, he founded the Society of the Divine Savior (Salvatorians) in 1881 and the Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Savior (Salvatorian Sisters) in 1888. He also organized groups of lay people to take part in the Church's mission of evangelisation using all ways and means. He died on 8 September 1918 in Tafers in Switzerland.

THE MIRACLE

A young couple that was expecting a baby in 2014 in Jundiai (Brazil), was informed by several medical doctors and specialists that their unborn child was suffering an incurable bone disease (skeletal dysplasia). Being members of a group of Lay Salvatorians, the parents began to pray through the intercession of the Venerable Servant of God, Fr. Francis Jordan, inviting other members of the Salvatorian Family to join them. The child was born in a complete healthy condition on 8 September 2014, the day of Fr. Francis Jordan's death anniversary. After the required canonical procedures had been successfully completed, the Holy Father, Pope Francis declared that this miraculous healing was worked by God through the

Towards the beatification The declaration of the Pope on 19 June 2020 finishes the process on the miracle and opens definitely the wav towards the beatification of Fr. Francis Jordan. As soon as the date and place of the beatification ceremony will be determined by the Holy See, we will announce it. For more information about Fr. Her parents received the news of her birth in 2014, but due to difficulties during pregnancy, they undergo several tests.

After one of them, made in Suo Paulo, Brazil, they tell him that the mother would have a tumor in the placenta and that the girl would be born with dwarfism. Pray with their group to Father Jordan and girl Livia is born perfectly healthy on September 08, feast of the birth of the Virgin and Easter of Father Jordan.

This was the miracle approved by the Holy See for the Beatification of Jordan.

BEATIFICATION OF SALVATORIAN FOUNDER, FR FRANCIS MARY OF THE CROSS JORDAN

When we want to celebrate, we usually gather in one place with our family and friends to share our joy and to let others know about the wonderful thing that has occurred. The COVID-19 pandemic has made this challenging. However, in the same way that the pandemic did not stop them sharing the excitement of a presbyteral ordination last year, in May this year the Salvatorians will be celebrating the beatification of their founder, Fr Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan. This is a living demonstration of their charism of using all ways and means to spread the Good News, overcoming all barriers and hurdles.

Fr Francis Jordan was born John Baptist Jordan on 16th June 1848 in Gurtweil near the Black Forest in Germany. Despite his poor education (which almost stopped him from becoming a priest), he completed his studies with efficiency in over 40 languages. He was known to spend much time in private prayer, and his time as a painter and decorator showed him the vast material and spiritual needs of the people. All of these things would influence his life and the development of the Salvatorian charism. After his ordination in 1878 he had thoughts of uniting all Catholics to spread and defend the faith. His vision was for a society of clergy, religious and laity working together for this mission. During a tour of the Middle East, Fr Jordan had a profound experience while on Mount Lebanon. The words of John 17:3 - "This is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the One whom you sent, Jesus Christ" - came to him. He returned home determined to make his ideas a reality. The pre-Vatican II Church, however, was not ready for this and encouraged him to start a religious order instead. Therefore, on 8th December 1881 three priests, including Fr Jordan, made their vows to what we now know as the Society of the Divine Saviour. Exactly 7 years later the congregation of sisters was founded. Fr Jordan died on 8th September 1918 in Tafers, Switzerland and his remains were transferred to the Motherhouse in Rome in 1956.

The Second Vatican Council called for religious communities to return to the vision of their founders, and it was at this time that the Salvatorians were able to include the laity in their family. Today, spread over more than 40 countries, there are over 3000 Salvatorians (clergy, religious and laity) not resting content until all know, love and serve Jesus as their saviour. Using all the ways and means that God inspires in them, they too are motivated by those same words of scripture from John 17:3. Salvatorians work through a number of apostolates such as parishes, pastoral care, aged care, youth work and as missionaries. Through this work the vision of Fr Francis Jordan is becoming more and more of a reality.

The process for the beatification of Fr Jordan commenced in 1943. After collection and assessment of his history and works, Pope Benedict XVI acknowledged the "heroicity of his virtues" (i.e. that he lived a holy life) and declared him Venerable Francis Jordan in 2011. The next step required so that he could be called "Blessed" was the attribution of a miracle. In 2014 a young couple were advised that their unborn child had an incurable disease, skeletal dysplasia. Being Lay Salvatorians, they prayed through the intercession of Venerable Francis



Jordan, and invited their Salvatorian family to join them. On the 8th September 2014, their daughter was born completely healthy. In 2020 Pope Francis confirmed the miracle and set the date for Francis Jordan's beatification, 15th May 2021.

While the celebrations for this beatification may initially look more subdued than those that have occurred before due the current pandemic situation, there is certainly an unquenchable fire burning in the Salvatorians as they look for innovative ways to commemorate this long-awaited event. Whether it be through documentaries, international webinars, national and local celebrations, or the sharing of the "unofficial Salvatorian dessert" of Black Forest cake, Salvatorians worldwide will be united more than ever despite being physically apart. In Australia, NSW Salvatorians will celebrate a thanksgiving Mass for the beatification with their local Bishop, Most Rev Anthony

FIRST READING

ACTS 1:1-11

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Why are you standing here looking into the sky? Jesus has been taken into heaven.

In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven. He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God. When he had been at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is,' he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about: John baptised with water but you, not many days from now, will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.'

Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come? Are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by his own authority, but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and then you will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to the ends of the earth.'

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight. They were still staring into the sky when suddenly two men in white were standing near them and they said, 'Why are vou men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky? Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven, this same Jesus will come back in the same way as you have seen him go there.'

He has put all things under his feet, and made him, as the ruler of everything, the head of the Church; which is his body, the fullness of him who fills the whole creation.

MK 16:15-20

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

The Lord Jesus was taken into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God.

Jesus showed himself to the Eleven and said to them, 'Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation. He who believes and is baptised is saved; he who does not believe will be condemned. These are the signs that will be associated with believers: in my name they will cast out devils; they will have the gift of tongues; they will pick up snakes in their hands, and be unharmed should they drink deadly poison; they will lay their hands on the sick, who will recover.'

And so the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place, while they, going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word by the signs that accompanied it.

COMMUNION ANTIPHON MT 28:20

SCRIPTURE COMMENTARY

The Ascension was a turning point in the life of the church. It brought closure to the earthly activity of Jesus and launched the apostles on their own ministry. Jesus tells them that the time of fulfilment is approaching. They question him about the restoration of Israel. Since such restoration was considered a sign of the endtime, their question shows that they believed that the endtime had indeed come. Jesus informs them that though he will leave them, they will experience him through the presence of the Spirit. The actual account of the ascension is brief. Jesus is lifted up and concealed by a cloud. The church is now in a liminal state. Jesus has left, but the Spirit has not vet come.

The liturgical celebration described in the psalm is the enthronement of God. This enthronement appears to establish God's sovereign reign. The claim that the Lord rules over all the earth either points to the preeminence of the God of Israel over all other gods or it is an assertion of monotheistic faith. The title 'Most High', was the name given to 'the creator of heaven and earth' (Gen 14:19). Israel applied both the title and all of the attributes associated with it to its own God. In their minds, their God was not only king over all the earth and all the peoples that dwelt there, but was also king over all of the powers of heaven.

The passage from Ephesians 1:17-23 is a prayer for wisdom and revelation, gifts that are necessary for insight and understanding. It acclaims the power of God that raised Christ from the dead and seated Christ in the place of honour in heaven; it made all things subject to Christ and exalted Christ as head of the church. It is this same power that is now called upon. The image of Christ is guite exalted. Having been raised from the dead, Christ now sits at God's right hand, high above all of the other heavenly creatures. Exalted by God, Christ is made the head of the church, which is the body of Christ. As members of this exalted body, believers share in Christ's fullness.

The overarching theme of Ephesians 4:1-13 is the unity within the church. It opens with a catalogue of social virtues that foster community harmony and preserve the unity that comes from the Spirit. The body with its many, diverse and interdependent members is an apt image of this living church. Its unity, grounded in membership in the one body of Christ, is expressed in the Christians' allegiance to one Lord, their commitment to one faith, and their practice of one baptism. The diversity within the church need not be threatened by this unity. A church united in its members is an apt manifestation of Christ who, in his exaltation, has matured to his full stature, bestowing grace on all without altering their diversity.

The account of the ascension of Jesus marks a turning point in his relationship with his closest followers. It reports the commission to preach the gospel to all. The salvific nature of this gospel is clear: Those who believe will be saved; those who do not believe will be condemned. Faith in the message of the gospel is crowned by baptism into the death and resurrection of Jesus. Taken from their sight, as exalted Lord, Jesus then takes his rightful place of privilege next to God. The concluding verse succinctly summarises the entire apostolic age: the apostles went into the entire world and preached the gospel; the Lord was with them, confirming their ministry through wondrous sians.
