LETTER FROM FR GREG

I was born on the 9th April 1985 into an agricultural family. I have two sisters. From an early age my mother read the Bible to my sisters and me. When I was just a boy, my father was taken to hospital. This began a period in which I had to suddenly become a grown man. My father's illness lasted eighteen years, of which a decade was spent in various hospitals. You could say my family accompanied my father in his illness in a devoted way. You could even say it was a type of Stations of the Cross, the way we walked with our Lord Jesus Christ.

When I received my first Holy Communion, I fulfilled my dream to be an altar boy. I was very committed and served for 10 years. Many times at night I would pray the rosary with my mother and sisters for the health of my father. And every day after school, I would help my mother with the daily work on the farm.

One year my parish priest sent my two friends and me on a retreat, which led me to encounter the Salvatorians. Each year afterwards I went back to this retreat. On many occasions whilst there, the idea of entering the seminary came to me. After attending these retreats five times, the Lord God led me to understand that it was my destiny and that I shouldn't resist. I made the decision to join a religious seminary.

When I told my parents of my decision, my father did not even want to hear about it as he wanted to see his son take over everything that he had. But I stood my ground and said that I would enter the seminary. Documents were then submitted and in September of that year, I began my novitiate. After I had been at the seminary for six months, my father made peace with my decision and was very proud that his son was training to be a priest. I had been studying for three years when my father's health deteriorated and he died a few weeks later. My father's death was a difficult experience for me and I even considered leaving the seminary to take care of my mother; but the Lord God again guided me in my life and the life of my mother and so a year and a half after the death of my father I made my final vows and three years after my father's death

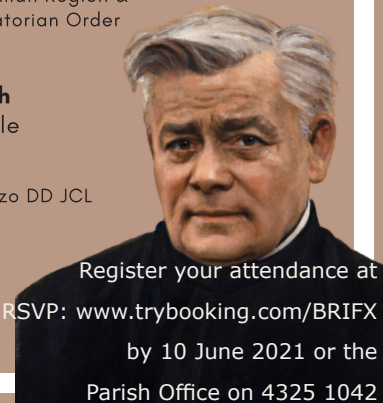

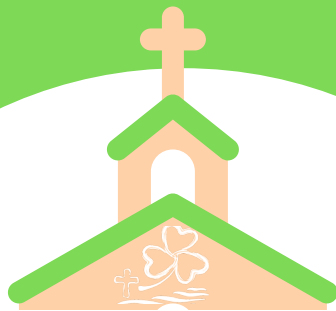

The eleven disciples set out for Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'

COMMUNION ANTIPHON

Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.

SCRIPTURE COMMENTARY

Moses admonishes the people to commit themselves to the Lord, pointing out the singular majesty of the God who has taken such a personal interest in their welfare. God's mighty deeds include: divine revelation itself; the election of Israel; and God's deliverance of them through numerous signs and wonders. From a historical point of view, the exodus involved God and the people of Israel. From a theological point of view, it was God's victory over the forces of the gods of Egypt. For these reasons, Moses encourages the

people to commit themselves to this God, who had been so good to them in the past; to accept God's law and obey it, so that God would be equally good to them in the future.

The psalm response expresses Israel's faith in God. This faith is rooted in the truth of God's word, the faithfulness of God's works, the justice of God's covenant, and the steadfastness of God's love. Everything else flows from this. God's word is as firm as is God's own self. The order and stability manifested through the marvels of creation not only stem from God's power and faithfulness, they witness to it. All of this is grounded in the steadfastness of covenant loyalty. The trustworthiness of God's word parallels the constancy of God's covenant. After considering various wisdom themes, the psalm ends on the theme of covenant kindness.

Paul explains the unique privilege of being children of God, led by the Spirit. He uses 'spirit' in various ways: the Spirit of God or Christ is a divine reality; the spirit of slavery is a disposition or mentality; the spirit of adoption is a relationship. Paul identifies the children of God as those who are compelled by the Spirit. He further states that we are children of God through the sonship of Christ. When we are joined to Jesus, the divine Son, we are led by the same Spirit that led him. Thus it is with and through Christ that we become children of God. Therefore, if Jesus can call God Abba, then we who are joined to him can as well.

The commissioning of the disciples takes place on a mountain. The trinitarian formula for Baptism given there gathers together elements already found in Jesus' teaching. Throughout his ministry, Jesus spoke of God as Father (cf. Matt 11:25-27), indicating the intimate relationship that exists there. He also spoke of the Spirit who came upon him at his baptism (cf. Matt 3:16) and through whose power he cast out demons (cf. 12:28-32). It is in this threefold name (one name, not three) that the disciples are to baptise. The specific teaching alluded to here is moral, not doctrinal. It calls for observance of Jesus' commandments. Jesus inaugurated the reign of God, at the heart of which is a radically different way of life.
