ALLELUIA! HAPPY EASTER! HE IS RISEN INDEED, ALLELUIA!

In this Year of Community in our parish, we today celebrate Easter and rejoice that Jesus Christ has risen and is no longer among the dead. Where, then, can we find Him? Where will He be? Jesus is among us and we can now encounter the Risen Christ in many ways. Have your eyes been opened? Have your sins been forgiven? Have you returned home? Have you deepened your trust in God and in others during this Lenten season? Have those parts of you that were dead returned to life?

Our Lenten journey is complete and we now follow the Easter road that will lead us to see the Risen Lord in many new ways. Was there anything that was different for you during this Holy Week? Did you try or experience anything new? Is today a new day for you? Can this Easter fulfil your dreams and desires? We are commissioned to tell the story and to testify through our lives of the one who rose from the dead. Today is a new day - let us rejoice and be glad!!!! Let us go forth and proclaim, "Jesus is risen indeed!" Let us trust God in all the situations of our lives as Jesus trusted His Heavenly Father during Holy Week when he suffered, died and rose from the death for you and for me!

Our Savior, Jesus Christ, has conquered death and everything that diminishes the Divine life in us and amongst us. His resurrection from the dead is not simply a fact of history to be retold at Easter. It is a mystery to be lived everyday. As Christians, we are just as inspired by the presence of Jesus among us today as those who first saw the empty tomb.

Like them, we too know that Jesus is not found amongst the dead. He lives among us in the community gathered to celebrate the Eucharist. He lives in the Gospel that is proclaimed by word and deed. Through the Sacraments of the Church, he gathers disciples, heals the sick, reconciles sinners and calls us to service. In the Church's outreach, it is the hand of Jesus that lifts up the poor, feeds the hungry, shelters the homeless and visits the confined. In these ways, and many others, we give witness to the mystery of Jesus living among us. Indeed, in this way we become the Body of Christ for the world.

This great Easter mystery cannot be lived in isolation. It requires the bonds of community to support us and to challenge us. Every Sunday, the Church gathers as the Body





The teaching of scripture is that he must rise from the dead.

It was very early on the first day of the week and still dark, when Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb' she said 'and we don't know where they have put him.'

So Peter set out with the other disciple to go to the tomb. They ran together, but the other disciple, running faster than Peter, reached the tomb first; he bent down and saw the linen cloths lying on the ground, but did not go in. Simon Peter who was following now came up, went right into the tomb, saw the linen cloths on the ground, Look for the things that are in heaven, and also the cloth that had been over his

head; this was not with the linen cloths but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in; he saw and he believed. Till this moment they had failed to understand the teaching of scripture, that he must rise from the dead.


