WE'RE MAKING OUR CHURCH MORE WELCOMING!

RENOVATION TO BEGIN SOON

We were recently awarded a \$25,000 Community Building government grant to assist in making our church more welcoming. We will do this, and as you would remember from our foyer renovation proposal launched in 2021, by replacing all exterior doors to the church with timber look aluminium and glass doors and replacing the current wall between the church body and the foyer with a framed sound reducing glass wall with automatic opening doors, greatly assisting anybody with physical limitations.

In addition we wish to remove the heavy, prison like roller shutters to the choir loft and piety stall. In the interests of retaining our heritage, we will use one of the current iron grill entry doors to the church body at the top of the stairs to the choir loft to provide the necessary security to that space, and even more excitingly we will incorporate the etched glass in the current entry doors and header in the new entry to the piety stall.

These plans will make our church, and particularly our foyer, lighter, friendlier and more welcoming.

Whilst the grant covers the exterior doors and glass wall, we are looking for your assistance to meet the cost of the piety stall and choir stairs reno at approximately \$9,000 and to this end we have placed Parish Project envelopes at each of the pews today in the hope that we will have your financial support.

Be assured that while we are ever mindful of the importance of maintenance and improvements to our church we also recognise that retaining the essence of St Patrick's is a priority, and that is our aim.

Work should commence in about one month and we'll keep you posted. In the meantime if you would like to know more, or how to donate directly, please speak with Father or call the Parish Office.





READINGS FOR THE 4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

CF. PS 32:5-6

The merciful love of the Lord fills the earth; by the word of the Lord the heavens were made, alleluia.

FIRST READING

ACTS 13:14, 43-52

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles We are now turning to the gentiles.

Paul and Barnabas carried on from Perga till they reached Antioch in Pisidia. Here they went to synagogue on the sabbath and took their seats.

When the meeting broke up, many Jews and devout converts joined Paul and Barnabas, and in their talks with them Paul and Barnabas urged them to remain faithful to the grace God had given them.

The next sabbath almost the whole town assembled to hear the word of God. When they saw the crowds, the Jews, prompted by jealousy, used blasphemies and contradicted everything Paul said. Then Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, 'We had to proclaim the word of God to you first, but since you have rejected it, since you do not think yourselves worthy of eternal life, we must turn to the pagans. For this is what the Lord commanded us to do when he said:

I have made you a light for the nations, so that my salvation may reach the ends of the earth.'

It made the pagans very happy to hear this and they thanked the Lord for his message; all who were destined for eternal life became believers. Thus the word of the Lord spread through the whole countryside.

But the Jews worked upon some of the devout women of the upper classes and the leading men of the city and persuaded them to turn against Paul and Barnabas and expel them from their territory. So they shook the dust from their feet in defiance and went off to Iconium; but the disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.
