SCRIPTURE COMMENTARY

Mention of Theophilus links Acts with the gospel of Luke (v.1, cf. Luke 1:3). Jesus is said to have remained on earth for forty days. This recalls the number of days during which Moses was instructed in the law (cf. Exod 34:28) and Elijah journeyed toward the mountain of God (1 Kgs 19:8). In this way the author connects Jesus with the expectations of Israel. Remaining in Jerusalem is also important. The mission must go forth from there to the ends of the world (v.8; cf. Isa 2:3). Finally, Jesus' announcement of the apostles' baptism in the Holy Spirit recalls an earlier statement of John the Baptist (cf. Luke 3:16). These lines draw the continuity between Israel and the church.

The psalm describes a ritual of enthronement. It opens with a call to praise God. The enthronement itself appears to establish God's sovereign reign. The Lord rules over all the earth (vv.3, 8), over all nations (v.9). God's kingship has cosmic and mythological underpinnings. The ancients believed that before creation the forces of good were in mortal combat with the forces of evil. Once the battle was won, a heavenly palace was constructed for the victor. While there is no explicit mention of cosmic victory in this psalm, the title 'Most High' was the name given to 'the creator of heaven and earth' (Gen 14:19). Israel believed that its God was king over all.

The second reading, though addressed to believers, is a series of intercessions. While the gifts for which the petitioner prays flow from faith in 'our Lord Jesus Christ', the relevance of the wisdom tradition is clear. The prayer is for a spirit of wisdom and revelation, gifts that are necessary for insight and understanding. The power referred to throughout the reading belongs to God. It was God's power that raised Christ from the dead and seated Christ in the place of honour in heaven; it was God's power that made all things subject to Christ and exalted Christ as head of the church. It is this same power that is now called upon.

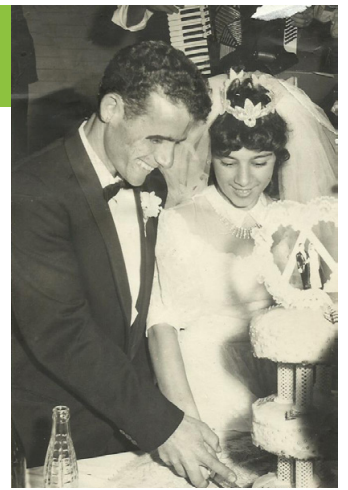

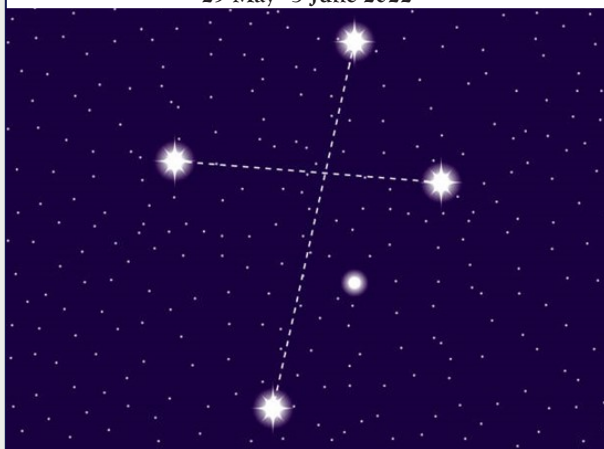

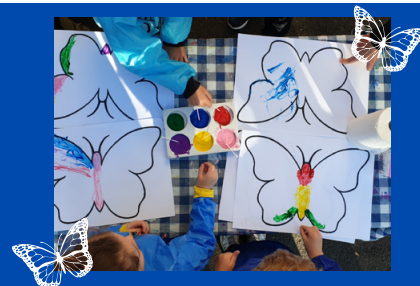
Movie: **COURTING MOM & DAD** (PG)

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

ACTS 1:11

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens?

This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

FIRST READING

ACTS 1:1-11

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

Why are you standing here looking into the sky? Jesus has been taken into heaven.

In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven. He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God. When he had been at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is,' he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about: John baptised with water but you, not many days from now, will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.'

Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come? Are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by his own authority, but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and then you will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to the ends of the earth.'

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight. They were still staring into the sky when suddenly two men in white were standing near them and they said, 'Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky? Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven, this same Jesus will come back in the same way as you have seen him go there.'

May he enlighten the eyes of your mind so that you can see what hope his call holds for you, what rich glories he has promised the saints will inherit and how infinitely great is the power that he has exercised for us believers. This you can tell from the strength of his power at work in Christ, when he used it to raise him from the dead and to make him sit at his right hand, in heaven, far above every Sovereignty, Authority, Power, or Domination, or any other name that can be named, not only in this age, but also in the age to come. He has put all things under his feet, and made him, as the ruler of everything, the head of the Church; which is his body, the fullness of him who fills the whole creation.

'And now I am sending down to you what the Father has promised. Stay in the city then, until you are clothed with the power from on high.' Then he took them out as far as the outskirts of Bethany, and lifting up his hands he blessed them. Now as he blessed them, he withdrew from them and was carried up to heaven. They worshipped him and then went back to Jerusalem full of joy; and they were continually in the Temple praising God.

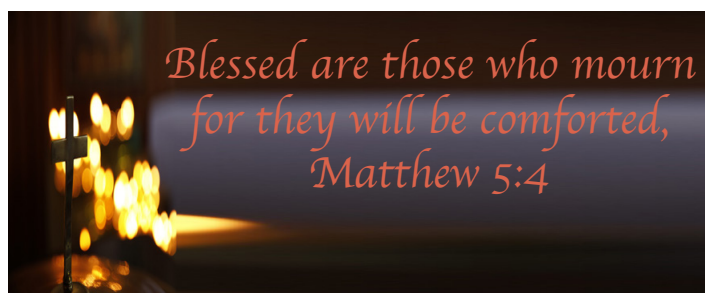
