A COMMUNITY UNITED: GOSFORD PARISH SYNODAL ASSEMBLY

On Saturday, 16th November, the vibrant community of Gosford Parish—Shrine of St John Paul II—came together for a landmark event: the Parish Synodal Assembly. Held in the school hall, the assembly gathered parishioners in a spirit of prayer, reflection, and discussion, aiming to discern the future direction of our parish.

The day was a tapestry of faith-filled activities and inspiring talks. Beginning with the celebration of Mass, Fr. Greg set the tone by reflecting on the themes of past years and offering a preview of the 2025 theme, which will be officially launched at the beginning of Advent. This was followed by an enlightening reflection from Patti Beattie, who delved into the meaning of being a Synodal Church and the significance of 'synodality' in our shared mission.

Adding a unique perspective, Kelly Paget shared her experience as a laywoman contributing to the global Synod in October, providing invaluable insights into the broader Church context. Scott Beattie then highlighted the role of our Parish Pastoral Council (PPC), explaining how its structure aligns with our Vision and Mission Statement while supporting the various ministry areas within the parish.

The heart of the assembly lay in the methodology of "Conversations in the Spirit," which Patti Beattie guided with great clarity. This process invited participants to engage in three rounds of prayerful discernment: first focusing on their individual calling, then reflecting on the insights shared within their groups, and finally discussing the parish's collective future. Each table group summarized their discussions, with their ideas now set to be collated by the PPC as a foundation for future planning.

The richness of the conversations was evident, fostering a profound sense of gratitude for the dedication and talents of those who already serve the parish. The day also opened new pathways for others to step forward and contribute to the shared mission.

This event was a true testament to the power of collaboration and community.



As we look ahead to Advent and beyond, the Parish Synodal Assembly reminds us of the strength found in unity, the blessings of shared discernment, and the hope of building a vibrant future together as a Synodal Church.

NOVEMBER PWBB APPEAL

WHO DOES PASTORAL WORKS BROKEN BAY SUPPORT?

Every year, your donations to Pastoral Works Broken Bay (PWBB) support two key Diocesan ministries. They are the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) and Hospital Chaplaincy and Pastoral Care Program. PWBB also contributes financially to St Lucy's School and St Edmund's College for students with disabilities and the Ephpheta Centre which supports the deaf community.

1. CONFRATERNITY OF CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE (CCD)

In our Diocese, more than 700 volunteer catechists who have received specialised training provide religious education to over 12,000 Catholic students attending public primary and secondary schools in our local parish communities. CCD provides regular resources and newsletters for the students and their families. It is a vital evangelisation role and a vibrant, enriching, and rewarding ministry. Without your support, thousands of our young people in our Diocese would not receive Catholic education.

2. HOSPITAL CHAPLAINCY AND PASTORAL CARE PRACTITIONER PROGRAM

In the last financial year, our Priests and CatholicCare Pastoral Care Practitioners engaged with around 2,000 individuals (including patients, their families/friends/carers, and even hospital staff) across the seven hospitals in which they minister, representing around 5,000 pastoral visits. Their special ministry supports patients and their families when they are at their most vulnerable, and they are there for those who may not have a family. Sometimes, it may mean a simple conversation, a listening ear, or providing prayerful and sacramental support.

3. St Lucy's School

St Lucy's School is a Catholic K-12 school in the Dominican tradition for students with disabilities. They provide a holistic education, offering outstanding academic programs taught by special educators. At St Lucy's they view each child individually to unlock their unique potential and to encourage them to become independent.

4. ST EDMUND'S COLLEGE

St Edmund's is a Catholic 7 -12 high school for students with a wide range of disabilities including sensory impairment, intellectual disability, and autism. St Edmunds creates a holistic learning environment incorporating academics and personal wellbeing through co-curricular activities.

5. THE EPHPHETA CENTRE

Ephpheta means "Be Open". The Ephpheta Centre provides pastoral care, sacramental services, support, and advocacy for the deaf or hard of hearing. The chaplaincy team visits people confined to their homes, nursing homes, hospitals, and those in prison, as well as friendship community gatherings catering to people across Sydney and the Central Coast.




