### REFLECTION FOR A DAY OF CONSECRATED LIFE

Imagine a small oil lamp flickering in the darkness. It has burned for years, passing its light to others, keeping the flame alive. But if no new lamps are lit, the light will eventually fade. This is the challenge we face today: the call to consecrated life continues, but new vocations are needed to ensure that the light of Christ shines in our world.

On this Day of Consecrated Life, we give thanks for the religious men and women who have dedicated their lives to God. Their witness of faith, service, and love has shaped the Church and society in countless ways. From caring for the sick and educating the young to praying for the world and working for justice, religious life remains a vital expression of God's love. But today, we must also ask ourselves: who will continue this mission in the future?

Jesus tells us, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest" (Matthew 9:37-38). This command is as urgent now as it was when Jesus first spoke it. The Church needs new vocations— young men and women who are willing to hear God's call and respond with courage. But vocations do not appear out of nowhere. They are nurtured in families, parishes, and communities that pray, encourage, and support those who may be called to religious life.

Pope Francis reminds us, "Vocations are born in prayer and from prayer; and only in prayer can they persevere and bear fruit." If we want to see more vocations, we must pray fervently. We must pray that young people have the openness to hear God's call. We must pray for parents, that they support their children's response to a religious vocation. We must pray for our own hearts, that we become encouragers of vocations rather than obstacles to them.

Yet, prayer is only the beginning. We must also actively foster a culture of vocations. This means speaking positively about religious life, sharing the stories of inspiring saints and religious, and creating opportunities for young people to encounter consecrated men and women. It means showing them that religious life is not about giving up happiness, but about discovering a deeper joy in serving God and His people.

On this special day, let us renew our commitment to praying for vocations. Let us ask the Lord to touch the hearts of young men and women, inspiring them to follow Him in religious life. May our prayers be like that small oil lamp—keeping the flame of vocation burning brightly, ensuring that the light of Christ continues to shine for generations to come.

Since all the children share the same blood and flesh, Jesus too shared equally in it, so that by his death he could take away all the power of the devil, who had power over death, and set free all those who had been held in slavery all their lives by the

fear of death. For it was not the angels that he took to himself; he took to himself descent from Abraham. It was essential that he should in this way become completely like his brothers so that he could be a compassionate and trustworthy high priest of God's religion, able to atone for human sins. That is, because he has himself been through temptation he is able to help others who are tempted.

**GOSPEL****LUKE 2:22-40****A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke**

When the day came for them to be purified as laid down by the Law of Moses, the parents of Jesus took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord – observing what stands written in the Law of the Lord: Every first-born male must be consecrated to the Lord – and also to offer in sacrifice, in accordance with what is said in the Law of the Lord, a pair of turtle-doves or two young pigeons. Now in Jerusalem there was a man named Simeon. He was an upright and devout man; he looked forward to Israel's comforting and the Holy Spirit rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death until he had set eyes on the Christ of the Lord. Prompted by the Spirit he came to the Temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the Law required, he took him into his arms and blessed God, and he said: 'Now, Master, you can let your servant go in peace, just as you promised; because my eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared for all the nations to see, a light to enlighten the pagans and the glory of your people Israel.'

As the child's father and mother stood there wondering at the things that were being said about him, Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, 'You see this child: he is destined for the fall and for the rising of many in Israel, destined to be a sign that is rejected – and a sword will pierce your own soul too – so that the secret thoughts of many may be laid bare.'

There was a prophetess also, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was well on in years. Her days of girlhood over, she had been married for seven years before becoming a widow. She was now eighty-four years old and never

left the Temple, serving God night and day with fasting and prayer. She came by just at that moment and began to praise God; and she spoke of the child to all who looked forward to the deliverance of Jerusalem.

When they had done everything the Law of the Lord required, they went back to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. Meanwhile the child grew to maturity, and he was filled with wisdom; and God's favour was with him.
