REFLECTION BY DIANNE BERGANT CSA

Lent is a time when we are reminded that there is nothing we can do to win our salvation. It is a pure gift from God. Like Jesus in the wilderness, we are to allow God's plan to unfold in and through us. Lent is a time for us to enter actively into the mysteries of the death and resurrection of Jesus, and there to marvel at what God has done for us.


The temptations of Jesus are the same temptations that we face when we are inclined to think that somehow we are in control. While the goals of the temptations may be admirable – feed the hungry, bring the world under the control of good, trust in God's power to protect us – we often choose to accomplish them in ways that are less than admirable. We try to perform the extraordinary so that what we do reflects favourably on us.

We use brute force in order to achieve control. We put God to the test rather than live peacefully with God's plan as it unfolds within and around us. We seek to become the super-hero, the super-minister, the super-Christian on our own. In his responses to the tempter, we see Jesus constantly deferring to the power of God:

It is not by bread alone . . . worship only God . . . do not put God to the test. In a real sense, these temptations are a reminder that the fundamental temptation is to deny our human limitations and refuse to let God be God for us.

After his baptism Jesus was driven by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness where the devil put him to the test. Jesus was offered three shortcuts to his living in harmony with the will of his Heavenly Father.

For Families in Crisis

Let us pray that broken families might discover the cure for their wounds through forgiveness, rediscovering each others' gifts, even in their differences.

First, when he was hungry there would be bread out of stones.

Second, when he wanted to change the world he could have absolute political power.

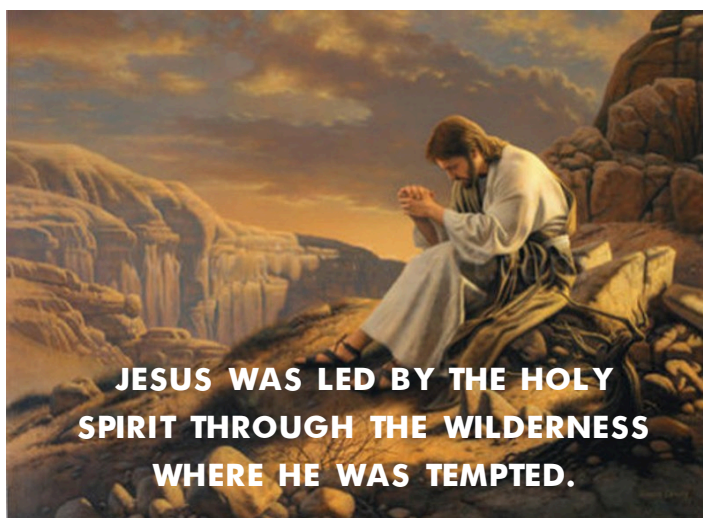
Third, when he needed to take risks, angels would keep him safe.


Our baptism does not insulate us from the same threefold pattern of temptation. Do you find yourself saying: I want the whole world to change to satisfy me, or I want to exercise power over others, or I want to take stupid risks and come out unharmed, or all three!

What must we do when such temptations assail us?

Realise that such temptations are much less powerful than they seem – the last gasp of the vanquished devil. Imitate Jesus in going to the Scriptures, preferably the Gospels, in order to have the words to hurl back at the devil as you are tested.

We could pause to make a Lenten resolution to read a Gospel, and to do so confident of our Baptismal identity as beloved daughters and sons of God.

DAYS OF PENANCE

1. Abstinence from meat, and fasting, must be observed on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. All who have completed their eighteenth year and have not yet begun their sixtieth year are bound to fast. All who have completed their fourteenth year are bound to abstain.

2. On all other Fridays of the year including the Fridays of Lent, the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by performing any one of the following:

- (a) prayer – for example, Mass attendance; family prayer; a visit to a church or chapel; reading the Bible; making the Stations of the Cross; praying the rosary.
- (b) self-denial – for example, not eating meat; not eating sweets or dessert; giving up entertainment to spend time with the family; limiting food and drink so as to give to the poor of one's own country; limiting use of social media, smart phones or television.
- (c) helping others – for example, special attention to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely or overburdened.

PASSPORTS NOW AVAILABLE FROM THE CHURCH FOYER

Pilgrims across the Diocese will be able to participate in the **Jubilee Pilgrim Passport** initiative.

In much the same way as the famous Camino de Santiago pilgrimage has a passport that can be stamped along the way, you can get a Jubilee Pilgrim Passport from your Parish to commemorate the Jubilee Year. When visiting the Cathedral and the 3 Shrines of Hope, you can have your Passport stamped as a memorial of your time there. A "complete" passport is one where you have visited the Cathedral and each of the Jubilee Shrines of Hope across the Diocese, and had your passport stamped at each.

Upon **completing your passport**, you can receive the **Jubilee Local Pilgrim of Hope Certificate**, which together with your stamped Passport forms a memento of your participation in this Holy Year.

When you go to get your stamp: don't forget all the wonderful graces that are available "the Treasury of the Church" in this Jubilee Year!

God has entrusted the Church with the amazing gift of "Indulgences" – these gifts of grace are there waiting for us, but it is up to each one of us to actively receive them.

Generally to obtain an indulgence, some form of sacrifice of our time and attention is required, but it is such a tiny sacrifice compared to the marvelous graces we receive. Even the grace of a "partial indulgence" is so beneficial, so very worth a small gift of our time and attention to the God who loved us into being.

Don't just go to get the stamp! Let that stamp be a memorial for you of the fact that you went and made a small offering of your time and attention to our Lord!

1. Jubilee Passports can be stamped at each Shrine and the Cathedral to acknowledge visit and time of prayer within.
2. Once all three Shrines and Cathedral, with respective stamps, have been visited a Pilgrim's passport is "complete".
3. Pilgrims then have their passports verified at their own Parish office.
4. Each Parish will notify Mission Broken Bay with the names of those pilgrims who have completed their passports so that they may receive a special commemorative certificate signed by Bishop Anthony.
5. A live *Tally* is available on the www.bbjubilee.com.au website. Noting how many pilgrims have completed the Jubilee Shrines of Hope Pilgrimage and which parishes they are from.

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit through the wilderness, being tempted there by the devil for forty days. During that time he ate nothing and at the end he was hungry. Then the devil said to him, 'If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to turn into a loaf.' But Jesus replied, 'Scripture says: Man does not live on bread alone.' Then leading him to a height, the devil showed him in a moment of time all the kingdoms of the world and

said to him, 'I will give you all this power and the glory of these kingdoms, for it has been committed to me and I give it to anyone I choose. Worship me, then, and it shall all be yours.' But Jesus answered him, 'Scripture says: You must worship the Lord your God, and serve him alone.'

Then he led him to Jerusalem and made him stand on the parapet of the Temple. 'If you are the Son of God', he said to him 'throw yourself down from here, for scripture says: He will put his angels in charge of you to guard you, and again: They will hold you up on their hands in case you hurt your foot against a stone.
