In November 2024, Our Parish hosted its first **Parish Synodal Assembly**, bringing together approximately 70 parishioners, including leaders and Principals from our parish schools.

Participants were invited to prayerfully reflect, discern, listen, and engage in dialogue around the central conversation question: **"In our Year of Joy, how is God calling us to serve His mission in our parishes?"** This discussion was guided by the **Conversation in the Spirit** methodology, fostering a collaborative, prayerful and spiritual approach. Conversation in the Spirit involves encountering each other, listening to each other and guided discernment together.

The below provides a summary of the table conversations.

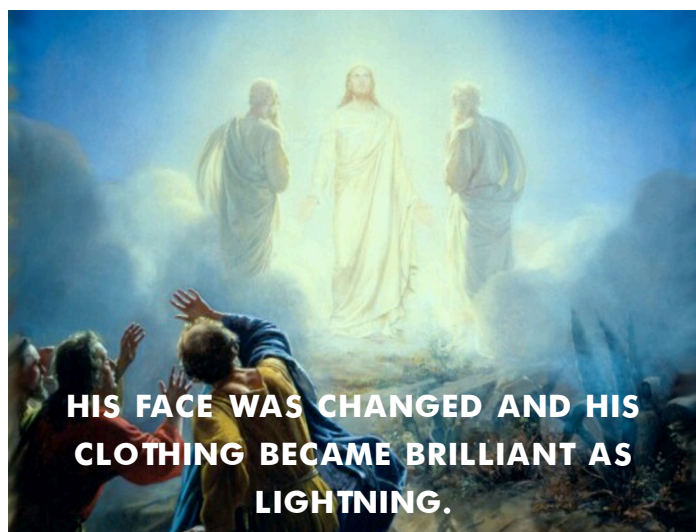
unity and outreach by engaging with the broader community, meeting people where they are, and living out the Gospel in daily interactions. Key approaches involve showing joy during Mass, enhancing youth education, and creating inclusive spaces that encourage faith-based conversations.

Additionally, participants called for retreats to discern individual gifts, fostering open communication to deepen connections, and prioritising forgiveness and healing to promote spiritual growth. Discussions emphasised the importance and value of listening, respecting differences, and embracing modern communication while maintaining meaningful human connections. Ideas were shared for attracting others and strengthening community ties, with a focus on encouraging faith-sharing across the ages, fostering friendship and humility, and creating opportunities for involvement in church ministries. Special attention is given to welcoming newcomers, offering inclusive support, and becoming beacons of hope and joy for the larger community.



Summary

Participants emphasised the importance of joy, connection, and active participation within the parish community. They highlighted the need for self-reflection, urging individuals to trust in God, embrace joy, and adopt positive attitudes to foster a welcoming and vibrant community. Suggestions included supporting parish ministries through prayer and discussion, aligning roles with individuals' gifts, and celebrating diversity within the parish. 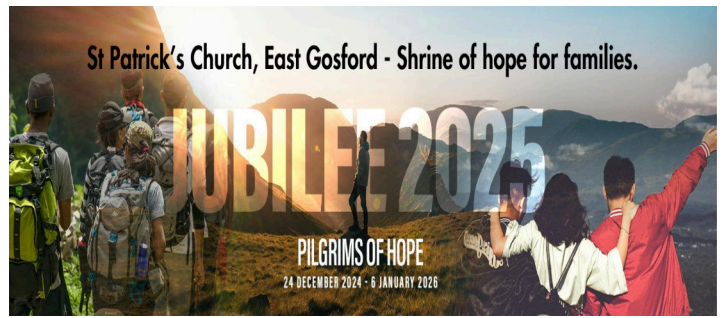

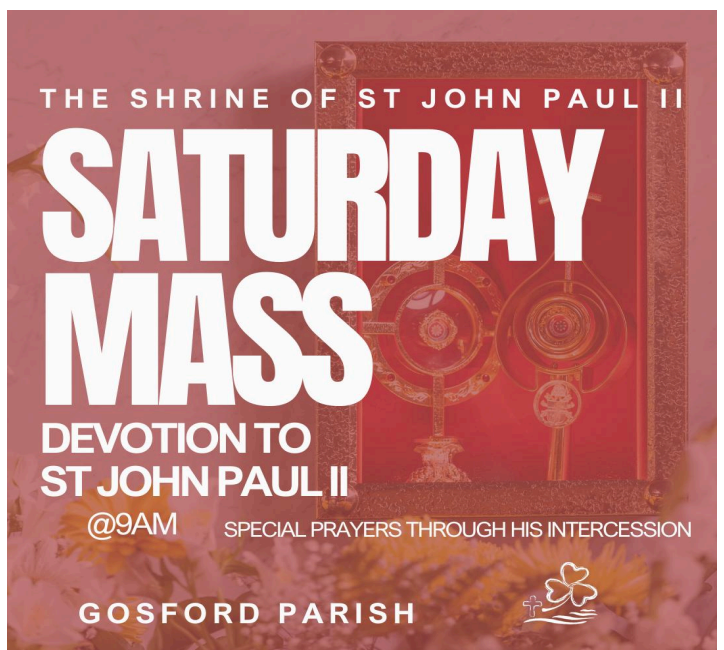
