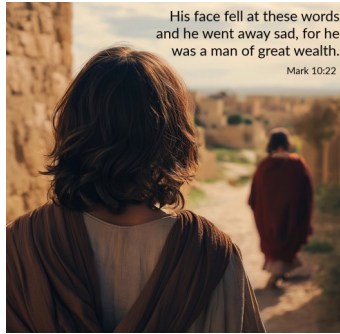

Women's Rosary - Saturday, Oct 26th, after the 9:30am Mass.

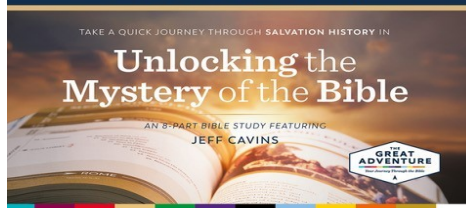

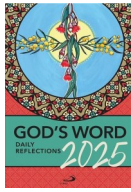
