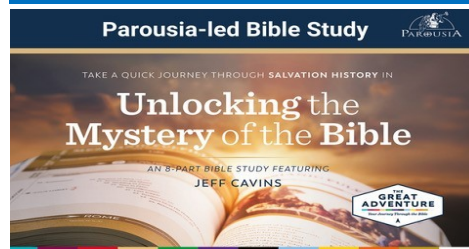
October is the Month of the Rosary. Here are some key dates for this month. You are invited to join in, so **Save the Date!**
