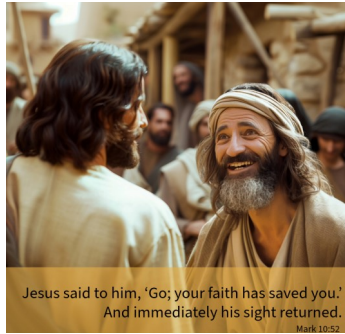

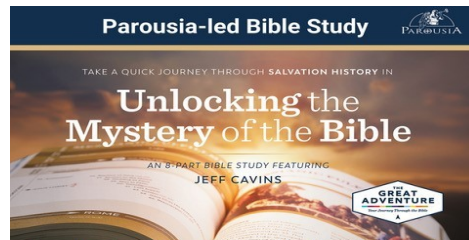
Thank you to all the parishioners who participated in our month-long rosary devotion. May it draw us closer to Jesus through his mother, Mary.
