

Our windows are kept locked for security reasons (people forget to re-lock them and we've had thefts), however, if you would like a window opened near your favourite pew, please just ask, and like the title above says, it "will be opened for you".



Wake up to the Poetry

Our Lord loved to unfurl the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah in his local synagogue. The poetic image of swords being hammered into ploughshares reverberated into his renouncing violence against the Roman occupying army in his own time. When will this picture come true for all human beings for all time?


Only God knows! We don't know any more than we know when a burglar might target our home. But our ignorance of God's timetable is no excuse for being fatalistic and sleepy. We have our own span of life providing the timetable for our own contribution to the hammering of swords into ploughshares.

We could pause for a moment to pray to be awake to our opportunities to shape society in the light of the vision of Isaiah and the practice of Jesus the Prince of Peace.

In 2018 many of us participated by telling our stories and listening to one another as we spoke of our hopes for the Catholic Church in Australia. It is now time to discern how these ideas might take shape. By its nature, discernment is a slow process, it takes time and effort.
