# proclaimed 2025 as a Jubilee Year, a sacred time of renewal and reflection. Along with the Jubilee Year, Christan Churches prepare to mark the 1,700th anniversary of

the Council of Nicea, the first of the great Ecumenical Councils, which developed the Nicene Creed stating that the Son is consubstantial with the Father. Pope Francis says, in his homily on the Feast of the

Conversion of St Paul, 25 January 2025, "This Creed is a common profession of faith that transcends all the divisions that have riven the Body of Christ over the centuries", and the anniversary of its proclamation, "an opportunity for all Christians who recite the same Creed and believe in the same God".

Realising the importance of the anniversary of the Nicene Creed this year, we may often recite the Nicene Creed in our Sunday Mass. Fr Biju OSH, PP
