Dear Parishioners,

With every New Year comes the opportunity for new beginnings and hopefully to make improvements in the way we go about things. I am doing the same for our parish and would like you to take special notice of the following:

• From 1st January 2025, there will be a couple of small changes in the parish office. Opening hours will be from 9am to 4pm Monday to Friday. Catherine Hutchison will be in attendance all weekdays with Margaret Cooper in attendance on Tues-Wed-Thurs only. Karen Price (Bookkeeper) will continue to attend the office on Wednesday and Jan Favaloro will still offer voluntary assistance on a Tuesday.

Bulletin:

- Going forward, the weekly bulletin will be reduced to a single (double sided) A4 sheet
- The format will be greatly simplified with importance being given to parish events and achievements, followed by Diocesan announcements and requests and then those of neighbouring parishes or outside of parish requests.
- The main details for regular parish ministries will be provided with a reference to either a phone number or email address for folk to make contact if they seek further information or assistance.
- Perhaps the biggest change to the bulletin will be the roster section. As each volunteer is provided with a roster directly, the roster 'section' will no longer be part of the bulletin. Instead the roster for the weekend masses after the one you are attending will be printed weekly and placed in the sacristy of each church and on the church notice boards. You are encouraged to view these (if necessary) to see if you are rostered the next week of if any sub-requests have been made which you might be able to fill.
 - When it comes to the rosters for Senior Servers/Junior Servers/Readers these can be viewed via the parish website at any time to check if you are rostered or sub-requests have been made as it is linked in real-time to any changes made using the 'Ministry Scheduler Programme' (MSP) - if you need assistance or a bit or re-training please reach out to the office staff.
- Requests to have something included in the bulletin need to submitted by 12 midday on Wednesday (no late submissions can be considered, sorry)

As you would have noticed over the last couple of weeks, all readings at our masses are now on the AV screens.
 This is why they will no longer be printed in the bulletin. I encourage you to closely follow the readings on our screens during mass.
