Insects, Heaven and Hell

The rich man ('Dives') is so totally *self*absorbed in the self-indulgence of his wealth that he does not even notice

poor Lazarus at his gate. He created such a huge chasm between himself and the poor that not one crumb of food or companionship could cross over to Lazarus.

This chasm, *created* by Dives, was fixed at the moment of his death so that not one part of the life of Paradise could cross over to him – not even a drop of water.
