On Laetare Sunday the Church invites us to rejoice for our salvation is near! Today's readings challenge us to review the past thoughtfully and look into the future joyfully! The history of God-human relationships is one of total fidelity (God) and opportunistic faithfulness (humans). A common temptation we humans all have is to want to manipulate God to our advantage.
