Growing up on a farm with a large garden, my parents always cursed the couch grass. It was a weed that spread like bushfire, with tough networking roots. However, this non-native species has become a go-to lawn variety throughout mainland Australia, because of its resilience and drought-resistance. It has gone from a curse to a plant of value. So it is with the Kingdom, or Reign, of God. We might not appreciate it as it starts to grow, but eventually we discover its extent and true value. The mustard plants in Jesus' time were considered weeds, and the birds they sheltered were a problem for the farmers. Yet Jesus considers the birds and needs as well. The Reign is valued by those who are the least in our world; the lowly are raised and the mighty brought down. Like the couch grass, what reminds you of Reign today?


