### Gospel Reflection

*Excerpt from; God’s Word 2018: Daily Reflections*

**Both the parables in today’s gospel point to the role that we are called to play in God’s plan. He takes care of the major part and leaves us with a small role.**

**However, the role he has assigned to us is fundamental. The farmer has to first of all scatter the seed and only then will God be able to do the rest, i.e.; making the seed sprout, grow and bear fruit.**

**Likewise, although the mustard seed itself is small, it has to be first sown into the ground. Once it is sown then its hidden ability to grow into the greatest of shrubs is triggered and it becomes one in which even birds can take shelter.**

**Since ‘a journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step’ we are given the task of taking a decisive step and playing a crucial role.**

WWCC: Are you a volunteer in our parish in a ministry where you are required to hold a Working With Children Clearance? Catechist, Children's Liturgy Leader, Senior Server etc? If so, you may be nearing the time for renewal as your WWC Clearance is valid for 5 years only. The NSW Office of the Children's Guardian will notify you via email 3 months prior to your expiry date with instructions on how to renew, HOWEVER, in order to receive this reminder email, you must ensure that your current email address is on record with the OCG. To do this you need to logon to their website [www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au], enter your current WWC number and re-enter your details, updating any necessary fields. If you need more information please contact the OCG on 9286 7219 who will guide you through the process.
