Gospel Reflection

Excerpt from; God's Word 2018: Daily Reflections

(Jesus) shared our human nature in all things but sin' (Fourth Eucharistic Prayer). Expanding this affirmation, the Epistle to the Hebrews states, that, in Jesus, 'we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin' (Heb 4:15) - a truth graphically illustrated in the gospel accounts of Jesus' confrontation with Satan during the forty days he spent in the wilderness before proclaiming his mission. 'The time is fulfilled,' he said to the Galileans, 'and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news.' Though this kingdom 'is not from this world' (]n 18:36), as Jesus assured Pontius Pilate, it is 'among us' here and now (Lk 17:21). The beginning of Lent is a good time to reflect on these texts. Paul's advice is: 'Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect' (Romans 12:2).


PROJECT COMPASSION 2018 PRAYER


