

PENTECOST SUNDAY 23rd May 2021 Gospel John 15:26-27;16:12-15

Reproduced from God's Word 2021: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

On the Jewish celebration of Pentecost which recalls God's establishment of a covenant with the people of Israel, the gift of the Spirit, 'the power from on high' (Luke 24:49) opens a new relationship with God and humankind. Signs associated with the event at Sinai are recalled: thunder, lightning, and fire (see Exodus 19: 16-20). The one nation, Israel, is transcended as peoples from many nations understand the disciples who are 'filled with the Holy Spirit', as they speak about the marvels of God'.

In the second reading Paul lists the contrasting characteristics of a life without the gift of the Spirit and a life 'guided by the Spirit'. We must examine those characteristics and hear Paul's exhortation: 'Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit'.

The Gospel reading selects two passages from Jesus' farewell discourse to his disciples. As he returns to the Father, the Spirit/Advocate will continue the presence of the divine among us. Filled with the Spirit, we will continue Jesus' mission of being witnesses to God. However, Jesus has not been able to communicate all the truths of God and God's design for us in the brief period of his ministry. He still has much to teach us. But that will be done down through the Christian ages in and through the presence of the Spirit/Advocate who has learnt from the Father, and 'will tell us of the things to come'.

The Plenary Council which started in 2018 is the highest form of gathering of the local church. The mission of this Council is to provide discernment and guidance for the activities of the Catholic Church in Australia in the context of today's society, for the optimisation of the church's activities at all levels, in living the teachings of Jesus and achievement of God's will.

Phase 1 Listening and Dialogue

Parishes throughout Australia submitted what was observed as needing attention.

Phase 2 Discernment

All the information from Phase 1 was collated to a coherent agenda which is now to be taken to the assemblies.

Phase 3 Assemblies

The first of these assemblies will be held in October 2021.

(Phases 2 & 3 have both been delayed due to Covid)

The message for all parishioners for Phase 3 is that we are aware, that "the Church is not the presence in our society it once was. We need to take a measure of that and make decisions accordingly. The culture in which we have to proclaim the Gospel is very different to what it was even 20 or 30 years ago ". (Archbishop of Brisbane Mark Caleridge)

To pray for the success of the Plenary Council is the task set for all parishioners over the coming months. All parishes of the Broken Bay Diocese have been given an icon of Blessed Mary, Star of the Sea, together with special prayer cards. In our parish, at both Wyong and Tumbi we will
