Jesus is truly the King of the universe. When Pilate asked, 'So you are king?' Jesus replied: 'You say that I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I have come Into the world.' The Book of Revelation says, 'He is the ruler of the kings on earth'. Prophet Daniel and other prophets had longforetold the kingship of Jesus. 2. Jesus' kingship is not of this world. He existed from eternity. It was through him that the universe was created and, as such, all things belong to him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion.

3.
