

Parish Finance update for the year ending 30 June 2018

Total income for the year is down 4.7% on last year, from \$150,999 to \$143,833, mostly due to a decrease in second collections. Total Expenses for the year have risen 9.2% this year from \$126829 to \$138502. Much of this increase relates to expenses for the Altar / Church, Office (excluding employment) and Pastoral programmes.

This has left the Parish with an operating surplus of \$5,331 which is down on last year's surplus of \$24,130. This year we are planning to utilise some of our surplus funds to undertake Major Capital works, the replacement of a large part of the Church roof. This cost is expected to be between \$30,000 and \$50,000.

As always, new Parishioners are encouraged to join our Planned Giving Programme. Existing Parishioners are also encouraged to review their existing pledges. Please contact the Parish office for more information.


August Safeguarding Message
