Excerpt from; God's Word 2018:

Daily Reflections

27th May 2018 Year B

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity which we celebrate today is a celebration of the mystery of God as a community of love. Throughout his life Jesus spoke about God as his Father, himself as God's only Son and the Holy Spirit as Counsellor. Jesus revealed the mystery of the Trinity to us, not only to let us know the truth about God, but also to reveal to us the truth about ourselves - as to what is our origin, where is our destiny and how to attain it. Love is the binding force of the three persons of the Trinity; so when we love we share in that community of love which is the Living God. This celebration of the abundance of God's love is an occasion for appreciating what God has done and continues to do for us. It calls on us to respond to the love of God, poured into our hearts by Christ and the Holy Spirit, and invites us to look forward to the day when we shall share in the glory of God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The Australian Bishops have identified the liturgical year of 2018 as a national Year of Youth. In November 2017, at the commencement of the Year of Youth, Bishop Peter formally handed over the CYBB Pilgrim Cross to the young people of Broken Bay. This Cross has been entrusted to young people to carry around the Diocese throughout the Year of Youth and will be in the Wyong Parish from the 27th of October to the 2nd of November.

It is hoped that the CYBB Pilgrim Cross and the Year of Youth Image will encourage parish celebrations of the Year of Youth. Parishes have been asked to collaborate with local community, including schools, to plan and host events and initiatives of youth outreach during this time.

The Year of Youth "invites the church into dialogue about the importance and life-giving presence of young people in the Church and society. It calls for dialogue and active engagement focused on the reconnection and renewal of a new generation of young people in the life of the Church".
