


REFLECTION 8.12.2024 SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR C

The awesome, austere and somewhat formidable figure of John the Baptist appears in our readings today, exhorting us to make straight the path for the Lord. In reflecting upon our own lives, we may often find that the paths which we have travelled (and are still travelling) are very far from straight, but complex, circuitous and indirect. This is an almost inescapable reality in our contemporary world. In listening to the Baptist's words, it is opportune to ask ourselves, 'How could I make the path of my own life a little straighter? What are the unnecessary complexities which I could easily let go of?' Simplicity is in itself a beautiful and desirable thing. Paradoxically, it is both very difficult to achieve, and yet ready at hand as soon as we desire it. A good first step in drawing near to it is to meditate upon the supreme simplicity of God.

PARISH CONSULTATION REPORT

- Fr Raul opened the meeting with a prayer and welcomed all attendees.
- Joe Cesca Chair of the Finance Committee presented the financial position of the Parish. Losses between \$20,000 and \$40,000 have been sustained over the past 3 years. The stewardship responsibility of all Parishioners to the future of Wyong Parish means that a solution to change these losses must be found.
- Tim Curran, Executive Director of CatholicCare gave detailed information on the **Youth Foyer** concept. This offers 16–22-year-olds who are at risk of or are experiencing homelessness a safe place to live for up to 2 years integrating housing, education, employment, and life skills.



Transitions and pathways to thriving through life with Youth Foyers

- Options to be considered include, a) no action, b) sale of carpark, which
 then could provide funds for parking, new buildings, and surplus funds for
 future needs.
- Restraints to be resolved, **a)** heritage listing of the presbytery could mean only a refurbishment possible, **b)** number of car spaces.
- A majority vote approved ongoing investigation to determine costings and definite direction.

- In conclusion, much work has still to be done. The continuing prayers of all Parishioners are a must to ensure the best solution is achieved.



THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading - Baruch 5:1-9

A reading from the prophet Baruch Jerusalem, take off your dress of sorrow and distress, put on the beauty of the glory of God for ever, wrap the cloak of the integrity of God around you, put the diadem of the glory of the Eternal on your head: since God means to show your splendour to every nation under heaven, since the name God gives you for ever will be, 'Peace through integrity, and honour through devotedness'. 




