SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER GOSPEL REFLECTION 9th May 2021 Gospel John 15:9-17

Reproduced from God's Word 2021: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

Peter's visit to Caesarea, the centre of Roman authority in Palestine, and his encounter with the centurion Cornelius marks a turning point in Luke's story of the mission of the early Church. The gift of baptism and participation in the Christian community can no longer be limited to the Jewish-Christians. Peter points out that God has made this clear. Before the administration of baptism, the Spirit had already descended upon the gathering. Rightly has this episode been called 'the Pentecost of the Gentiles'.

The Gospel reading picks up from last Sunday, continuing the theme of 'remaining', describing the nature of the relationship between the believer and Jesus as a relationship of love. A chain of love runs from the Father to the Son, and from the Son to the believer, but only if the believer keeps the commandments of Jesus. The centrepiece of John 15: 1-16: 3 follows in a passage that opens and closes with a description of Jesus' commandment: 'Love one another, as I have loved you'. Jesus tells his disciples of the greatness of his love for them – he lays down his life for them, as they are now his friends. They are dear to him because he has chosen them to be his own. Chosen to live within this communion of love, the believer lives a fruitful life, and receives whatever she or he asks of the Father.
