
The Third Sunday of Advent is known as "Gaudete" Sunday, after the lines in our entrance antiphon today "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice". This exhortation to joy, can often seem to be difficult to put into practice. Perhaps there are things in our lives or our world that we cannot rejoice over, and weigh our hearts down. But joy is, in fact, a natural human condition. God wants us to be happy, both in this world and the next. Let us ask ourselves "What are the things in my life and heart which may be holding me back from happiness—pride, fear, envy, worry, ambition, resentment? Let us open our hearts to Jesus, to come in with his winnowing fan and sweep them all away.

Rejoice, cry ont with joy and gladness: for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel.

Entrance Antiphon

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.

First Reading

Zephaniah 3:14-18 A reading from the prophet Zephaniah. Shout for joy, daughter of Zion, Israel, shout aloud ! Rejoice, exult with all your heart, daughter of Jerusalem ! The Lord has repealed your sentence; he has driven your enemies away. The Lord, the king of Israel, is in your midst; you have no more evil to fear.

When that day comes, word will come to Jerusalem: Zion, have no fear, do not let your hands fall limp. The Lord your God is in your midst, a victorious warrior.

He will exult with joy over you, he will renew you by his love; he will dance with shouts of joy for you as on a day of festival.

Responsorial Psalm

Isaiah 12:2-6 R. Cry out with joy and gladness: for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel.

Gospel Acclamation

Isaiah 61:1 (Luke 4:18) Alleluia, alleluia! The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

Gospel

Luke 3:10-18 A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke. When all the people asked John. 'What must we do?' he answered, 'If anyone has two tunics he must share with the man who has none, and the one with something to eat must do the same.' There were tax collectors too who came for baptism, and these said to him, 'Master, what must we do?' He said to them, 'Exact no more than your rate.' Some soldiers asked him in their turn, 'What about us? What must we do?' He said to them, 'No intimidation! No extortion! Be content with your pay!'

A feeling of expectancy had grown among the people, who were beginning to think that John might be the Christ, so John declared before them all, 'I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out.' As well as this, there were many other things he said to exhort the people and to announce the Good News to them.
