

Today's Gospel elaborates further on the teaching that Jesus began in our liturgy last week. We hear the concluding verse of last week's Gospel repeated in today's reading: Jesus himself is the bread sent by God; Jesus' flesh is the bread that is given for the life of the world. Jesus teaches with even greater emphasis that salvation comes to those who eat his Body and Blood. Many today continue to struggle to accept these words. But they are important words because they reveal our intimate connection with Jesus. This is the mystery that is at the heart of our eucharistic theology. In the elements of bread and wine, Jesus' Body and Blood are made truly present. When we share in the Body and Blood of Christ, Jesus himself comes to dwell within us. This communion with the Lord makes us one body, brings us eternal life, and sends us forth to be Christ's body for the life of the world.







As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from


