

In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus again predict his passion, death, and Resurrection to his disciples. The setting here is important. Jesus and his disciples are preparing to journey through Galilee, a Jewish territory in which Jesus has already encountered problems with the Pharisees. Having arrived at Capernaum, Jesus and his disciples enter a house. Jesus then calls forward a child and teaches the Twelve that to receive a child in Jesus' name is to receive both Jesus and the One who sent him. In this action, Jesus is teaching his disciples and us that when we serve the least ones among us, we serve Jesus himself. Who are the people without power or status in our society that Jesus is calling us to serve? Do we do so willingly? Jesus teaches that God's judgment of us will be based on this criterion alone.



October's assembly of the Synod of Bishops with their prayers. The Synod is first and foremost an event of prayer and listening that does not solely involve the members of the synodal assembly, but every baptised person, every particular Church.

Bishop Anthony and Kelly Paget are once again preparing to travel to Rome for this significant gathering, and we invite you to pray for both Bishop Anthony and Kelly; in both the lead up to their departure and their time whilst in Rome participating in the second session of the Synod.



A reading from the letter of St James. 
