


God's 'mighty hand' shows that there is one true God.

early Christians to speak easily of God as the Father, Jesus
Christ as the Son, and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Spirit. Matthew's Gospel closes with the famous
commission of the risen Jesus to his fearful disciples. His
disciples can no longer be limited to one people but must
come from all nations. A new people of God will be
baptised in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy
Spirit, and taught to observe what Jesus taught, the
teaching of Jesus, and baptised in Father, Son, and Holy
Spirit. But the risen Lord will be with us always-to the end
of time.
