In the readings today, Ezekiel, Paul and Jesus manifest their vocation as God's accredited ambassadors and prophets. Ezekiel is asked by God to go and preach to rebellious Israel. Paul, during his ministry, experiences the power of Satan as he is afflicted with a 'horn in the flesh'. Jesus was misunderstood and rejected by the people of his own home town.

In all three situations the protagonists are given strength and sustained by the power of God working in them. Jesus was aware of his role as the prophet sent by his Father and was not dissuaded by the opposition and rejection of his townsfolk. When we follow God's precepts and accept to be his messengers, we will experience moments of trial, misunderstanding and rejection. But we will always be strengthened and sustained by the plentiful grace of God.

Ezekiel 2:2-5
