Donation envelopes will be available in the church and donations to this appeal are tax deductible. Receipts will be issued as requested.

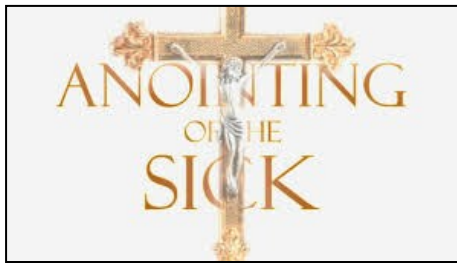

In your immense love, grant to your Church a pastor who will please you by his holiness and aid us with his unfailing care.

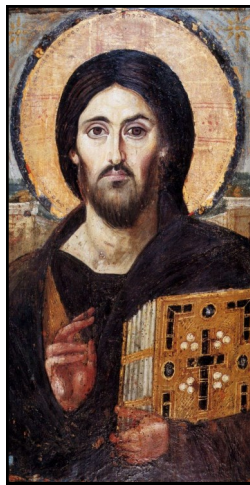
In your time, grant us the joy of welcoming a shepherd formed after your own heart.
