



HELPERS WANTED: WORLD DAY OF PRAYER MARCH 6TH 2020

well; if a man takes you to law and

would have your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. And if anyone orders you to go one mile, go two miles with him. Give to anyone who asks, and if anyone wants to borrow, do not turn away.
