
The presentation of candidates will be held at the weekend masses on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> May.

### PRESBYTERY UPDATE

**Dear Parishioners** 

As indicated in the last update (17 March 2024) the project will now be done in two phases. The plan for the renovation of the presbytery is complete and tenders for this first part of the project will be called for as soon as the tender documentation is complete. We anticipate that tenders will be called for in the next month. Once tenders are received and we have a firm idea on the costs of the renovation we will meet with the Diocese to obtain their formal approval to commence the renovations. At this stage we only have an informal approval from the Diocese. If any parishioner knows of a builder that would like to tender could they please contact the parish office with the details.

Based on the cost estimates, we have sufficient funds to go ahead with the renovations, thanks to the generosity of our parishioners.


It is anticipated that the renovations could be completed within a three to four month period after the tender is awarded. This means that our priests should be able to move into the renovated presbytery prior to December 2024 when the lease on their current accommodation expires.

Temporary arrangements for the office staff will be made during the construction period.

The plans for the new office building are being completed as well as the documents required to lodge a DA with Council. We are hoping to be able to lodge a DA towards the end of May. Once we lodge the DA we will also need to obtain formal approval from the Diocese for the building. We will also have to apply for a loan from the CDF. At this stage we do not have sufficient funds to complete the office building so our fund-raising efforts will continue. Thank you for your generosity.

### Sunday 12 May 2024: The Ascension of the Lord

#### Collect

Gladden us with holy joys, almighty God, and make us rejoice with devout thanksgiving, for the Ascension of Christ your Son is our exaltation, and where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

From the Acts of the Apostles Acts 1:1-11

Why are you standing here looking into the sky? Jesus has been taken into heaven. In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven. He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God. When he had been at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is,' he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about: John baptised with water but you, not many days from now, will be baptised with the Holy Spirit." Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come? Are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight. They were still staring into the sky when suddenly two men in white were standing near them and they said, 'Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky? ### **Second Reading**

From the first letter of St Paul to the Ephesians Eph 4:1-13

To the measure of the full stature of Christ.

I, the prisoner in the Lord, implore you to lead a life worthy of your vocation. Bear with one another charitably, in complete selflessness, gentleness and patience. Do all you can to preserve the unity of the Spirit by the peace that binds you together. There is one Body, one Spirit, just as you were all called into one and the same hope when you were called. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God who is Father of all, over all, through all and within all.

Each one of us, however, has been given his own share of grace, given as Christ allotted it. It was said that he would:

When he ascended to the height, he captured prisoners, he gave gifts to men.

When it says, 'he ascended', what can it mean if not that he descended right down to the lower regions of the earth? The one who rose higher than all the heavens to fill all things is none other than the one who descended. And to some, his gift was that they should be apostles; to some, prophets; to some, evangelists; to some, pastors and teachers; so that the saints together make a unity in the work of service, building up the body of Christ. In this way we are all to come to unity in our faith and in our knowledge of the Son of God, until we become the perfect Man, fully mature with the fullness of Christ himself. The Word of the Lord.

### Gospel

From the holy Gospel according to Mark Mk 16:15-20

The Lord Jesus was taken into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God.

Jesus showed himself to the Eleven and said to them, 'Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation. He who believes and is baptised is saved; he who does not believe will be condemned. These are the signs that will be associated with believers: in my name they will cast out devils; they will have the gift of tongues; they will pick up snakes in their hands, and be unharmed should they drink deadly poison; they will lay their hands on the sick, who will recover.'

And so the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place, while they, going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word by the signs that accompanied it.
