"The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (Gospel)

Dear Parishioners and visitors to the Parish,

In the context of this gospel (Jn6: 51-68) there is a verse that says: "he gave them bread from heaven for them to eat" this is a homolytic midrash, where the preacher takes that sentence and expands on it. The first part—he gave them bread from heaven refers to a vital faith relation with Jesus when the preacher speaks about to eat, he is referring directly to the Eucharist. Here the resurrected Lord is truly present hidden under the species of bread and wine. When we receive the Eucharist we ought to approach with great reverence and humility.





Collect

O God, who have prepared for those who love you good things which no eye can see, fill our hearts, we pray, with the warmth of your love, so that, loving you in all things and above all things, we may attain your promises, which surpass every human desire. First Reading

From the book of Proverbs Prv 9:1-6

Come and eat my bread; drink the wine I have prepared.

Wisdom has built herself a house, she has erected her seven pillars,

she has slaughtered her beasts, prepared her wine, she has laid her table.

She has dispatched her maidservants and proclaimed from the city's heights:

'Who is ignorant? Let him step this way.'

To the fool she says,
