On this earth we cannot see God's face as such but if we seek with pure hearts we will see the manifold signs of God's presence among us. We will recognise the presence of God in wondrous events, sometimes

unexpected, like the birth of a child. This was the sign given to King Ahaz of Judah to assure him that God-is-with-us.

The wonders of creation also point to the presence of the creator. The earth and all its fullness, and the world and all its peoples, are the work of God's hand. As we reflect on the immense varieties and all its peoples, we touch something of the abundant creativity of God.

I believe every adversity bears within itself the seeds of an equivalent or greater advantage. With regards to the roof ceiling tiles there has been a difficult challenge. Our building advisers have reviewed the overall quality of the work performed last year in July 2018, and have advised that the work was not carried out in accordance with best practice. We can now see them delaminating. If we attempt to complete only minor rectification works the tiles will continue to delaminate and fall off the ceiling. Unfortunately, this means that the whole job will need to be redone. Although the relocation is an inconvenience to parishioners, we would like to do the right thing to get the job completed to the best possible standard so that it can be enjoyed by us and future generations.

I expect the work will commence on 6^{TH} January 2020 and be completed prior to Easter.

As such, the last mass being held in the church will be on Saturday 4 January at 9am to allow us to move everything out of the Church. The Vigil Mass that night will be held in the hall.

CCI are covering the cost of the work on the ceiling. With new air conditioners in the church, improved sound system and new lighting we can look forward to an excellent church next year.

We will need to relocate to the hall but have managed to get two air conditioners for the hall paid for by CCI.

The new lighting will be LED ones. They use a fraction of the power but we will have to purchase them. However, we are able to get them at a very good price. They will be installed at no cost when the ceiling tiles are replaced.

We are grateful to Greg Malouf. He has been the primary support in helping us sort out the above ceiling difficulty. He has been a tower of strength with his generous availability, expert advice and initiative. He has negotiated very good deals for us in the Parish. We are very grateful to him for organising the four new air conditioners in the church and organising the associated electrical connections. He was similarly involved in organising the two new air conditioners in the hall.

So we are grateful for the above and look forward to improvements and opportunities provided by the ceiling tiles challenge.
