Today's liturgy proclaims that each one of us is regenerated to a living hope through the Resurrection of Christ. Nearly every day we die to something; our ego, a dream, an ambition, and old idea—in order to rise with a greater ability to love, to welcome the reality around us, to be enthusiastic in continuing the adventure of our lives. The mystery of death and resurrection goes on. The Resurrection, therefore, is not only a fact of past history but also a present reality. In our life, after every crisis we begin again; after ever rupture we rebuild. Through all these experiences the Lord teaches us how to go forward, and prepares the way for us to arrive at the final death and resurrection. In this pilgrimage the Christian must be characterised by faith in the Resurrection, being conscious that the present moment is a pass from death to life.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. Pope John Paul II wrote an encyclical in 1980 "Rich in Mercy". He emphasised not only the mercy God has shown us but also the need for the church to make known to others the mercy of God. In fact we best open up for God's mercy by showing mercy and forgiveness to others.

The encyclical is well summarised in John Paul's words: "The Church lives an authentic life when she professes and proclaims mercy—the most stupendous attribute of the Creator and of the Redeemer—and when she brings people close to the source of the Saviour's mercy, of which she is trustee and dispenser.

The Sunday of Divine Mercy derives from revelations given to St Faustina who died in 1938 and was canonised by John Paul II in the Year 2000. The context of the great act of God's mercy is the Christian Passover of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord. This is the basis of God's mercy for all humans.

FATHER CHRIS RILEY'S YOUTH OFF THE STREETS

I am currently recruiting additional people for our food roster for Father Chris Riley's Youth off the Streets, Don Bosco House, in Marrickville. Families from the Corpus Christi community have been supporting the house in Marrickville for the last 15 years. There are approximately 20 families/ people, who provide a frozen home cooked meal in a tinfoil container (Glad tuckaway box 20x18x5cm), once a month, which is collected by one of the volunteers at their home on a Sunday morning. They are all then taken that afternoon in Eskies to Don Bosco House in Marrickville. At the moment the drivers are only having to deliver twice a year.

I am looking for any new families/ people who would like to join the roster to either provide a food box once a month (or whenever possible). More urgently we need more people to make the deliveries. This would only be once a year as you are placed on a roster and can choose the month that suits you.

IMPORTANT SJ MEETING – WEDNESDAY 18 APRIL:

The Corpus Christi Parish St Ives social justice group (SJG) will meet on Wednesday April 18, at 7.30pm in the Church Hall. *This will be a very IMPORTANT meeting*. All parishioners are invited.

For the past 8 years I have been the coordinator of SJG. As I moved from St Ives two years ago and now live in Waverton within the North Sydney parish / Sydney Archdiocese, it is now time for me to step aside. Thus we need to appoint a new SJG co-ordinator, or failing that we need to find another way for the St Ives SJG projects & activities to continue.

SJG projects are managed by committed leaders who are continuing in their roles. Projects include (but are not restricted to) Timor-Leste Dominican schools & orphanage, Dee Why refugee community, Rwanda Youth Life Skills, and Indigenous education & support. Activities include regular meetings & communication, DVD nights and more.

The SJG co-ordinator provides umbrella promotion and support across all projects and activities and is a link back to the parish. Responsibilities include communication to members and the parish, organising and chairing meetings, acting as a contact point for project leaders, and raising awareness within the parish of significant and emerging social justice issues. This is an extremely rewarding voluntary role. Time commitment is minimal and flexible.
